
Spring Show 2026

KING OF THE SAVANNAH



Tappara Taitoluistelu will perform Savannin kuningas (King of the Savannah) – iceshow on Saturday 28th March 2.30 pm (14:30) in Hakametsä ice hall. All the skaters of our club will skate in the show - also the Little Stars, Big Stars, and Synchro Stars of the skating schools.

TICKETS

Tickets will be sold in advance at the skating schools' dress rehearsal on 23rd March 2026. The prices of tickets purchased in advance are 18 € for adults, 10 € for children (7–17 years old) and 50 € for family (2 adults + 2-3 children). You can buy admission tickets at Lippupiste (lippu.fi). To prevent a congestion in ticket sales on the day of the show, it would be desirable to buy tickets in advance.

In addition, it's possible to buy tickets on the day of the show at the ice hall ticket office starting at 1.30 pm (13:30). The ticket office is near the entrance. In this case, ticket prices are 20 € for adults, 12 € for children (7–17 years) and 60 € for family. Children (0–6 years) can enter the show for free.

PROGRAM PRACTICE

All skating school groups will practice their programs during weeks 11–13. Practices will include rehearsing the programs both without music and with music.



DRESS REHEARSAL

On Monday, 23rd March 2026, in Sentteri ice hall (at Kaukajärvi)

- Big stars and Synchro Stars 5.25–5.50 pm (17:25-17:50)

- Little Stars 5.55–6.20 pm (17:55-18:20)

All skating school students should be present at the dress rehearsal. Please note that all the skating school students are present at the dress rehearsal, so there will be many people. If possible, get your outfits and skates ready at home or in the car, so that the dressing rooms are not completely crowded.

ROLES AND CLOTHING

LITTLE STARS, BIG STARS AND SYNCHRO STARS will perform "the dawn" in the show. The performance is the first number of the show. The outfit in the show must be suitable for skating, for example, a shirt, pants/skirt and mittens. Ice hall is quite warm, so thick overalls are not necessary. The main colors in the outfits should be yellow and orange. The hole outfit should be the same color.

ON THE SHOW DAY

The entrance to the ice hall is through the AC-doors. The doors are located at the end of the building on the side of Kissanmaa. The stands on the A-hallway are assigned to the audience. When child wear show clothes, they get in for free. Parents need tickets.

LITTLE STARS, BIG STARS AND SYNCHRO STARS:

Parents bring the skaters to the ice hall with skates on their feet at 2 pm (14:00) near the toilets in the C-end. The instructors gather the skaters, and they move down to the ice rink together. When parents have left their children to the instructors, they can go to the audience to watch the children's performance. Immediately after the performance, the directors bring the children back to the same C-end near the toilets, where the parents pick them up back to the stands. Parents pick up their children immediately after the program ends!

When arriving at the ice hall, the child must wear a performance costume and skates (blade guards on the skates!). The C-end is small and there are many skaters, so there is no space in the C-end to start changing skates. Remember to bring a helmet for the child to the show. It is a good idea to put a name or sticker on the blade guards so everyone can identify their own. You should also ensure that the child has gone to the bathroom before performing.

There will probably be a traffic jam at the entrance to the hall, so be there in good time so your child is on time for his performance.



Please inform the head director of your child skating school if your child cannot participate in the performance so we don't wait for anyone in vain. If your child skates in two skating school groups, inform the head instructors of both skating schools which group the child will participate in the show.
